Awami Workers Party president Abid Hasan Minto and general secretary Farooq Tariq have appealed to people of Pakistan to observe 14 May as a day of mourning in solidarity with Karachi Ismaili community martyrs. “Today was one of the saddest day in history of Pakistan, the terrorists have attacked the most peaceful religious community of Pakistan” the AWP leaders said in a joint press statement.
