The Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IIT Madras) decided, on May 22, to 'derecognise' the Ambedkar-Periyar Study Circle (APSC), an independent student body of the institution. The APSC was created in April 2014 to foster conversation and raise awareness about Ambedkar-Periyar, Dalit figures in Indian history, and rampant caste violence in the country.
