Bangladesh: Gathering of Landless People Held in Barisal - Khasland should be given away to the genuine landless people

Last 16 May 2018, at 11 am Bangladesh Krishok Federation and Bangladesh Kishani Sabha centrally organized a discussion meeting titled "Evicting all illegal encroachments and establishment from the Khasland in Barisal district, permanent settlement should be given away to the genuine landless people in the Khasland" at Barisal Ashwinikumar Town Hall.



Bangladesh Krishok Federation Central President Badrul Alam was present in the meeting a chief guest. Mukul Nahar. At the end of the discussion meeting members and participants thronged joined a demonstration.



In the discussion meeting the speakers said that there is a lot of Khaslands and Khaschars in Barisal district as it is situated in the down stream areas of the country. A group of local Joteder, brokers and influential quarters illegally enjoyed this land. The leaders called up the government to evict the influential groups and recover the land in order to give settlement among the real landless people. They added that the landless members of the organization are living in Rasulpur Char adjacent to

Barisal City and so far they did not get settlement on the land. A group of influential land terrorists built illegal structure in the land. This illegal occupants should immediately be removed from the Char.



The leaders also added that in case of Khasland management and settlements there is a lot of irregularities and corruptions going on. As a result, the genuine landless people are deprived of the Khasland. They told the audience that at any cost, it is the responsibility of the government to perform a genuine and comprehensive agrarian reform as well as land reform by recovering the Khasland from the influential quarters.



The leaders also expressed their opinion that by coping with all sort of conspiracies and by waging a tough struggle the right of landless people to land should be established.

The leaders asked the landless people to keep unity among themselves. Unity is the main strength of the organization they opined.
