Iran : « La communauté universitaire et militante internationale demeure largement silencieuse »

mercredi 5 octobre 2022, par [Collectif international d'intellectuels et de militants](#) (Date de rédaction antérieure : 30 septembre 2022).

Un collectif d'intellectuels et de militants du monde entier, dont les philosophes Judith Butler, Angela Davis et Jacques Rancière, déplore, dans une tribune au « Monde », le faible écho rencontré par les féministes occidentales au sein des cercles universitaires et appelle à « une solidarité transnationale avec les femmes et les corps marginalisés en Iran ».

Le 16 septembre, Mahsa (Zhina [son prénom en kurde]) Amini, une jeune femme kurde iranienne de 22 ans, a été sauvagement assassinée par la police des mœurs de la République islamique d'Iran. Elle a été plusieurs fois frappée à la tête après son arrestation pour port « inapproprié » du hidjab. Un assassinat d'Etat parmi beaucoup d'autres, systématiquement et délibérément commis par le régime d'apartheid sexuel qui sévit en Iran. Depuis ce meurtre d'Etat, des manifestations ont eu lieu dans plusieurs villes iraniennes.

Cette révolte dans l'ensemble du pays ne vise pas uniquement le meurtre brutal de Mahsa, mais l'essence même du régime islamique. Et la revendication est claire et nette : la fin d'un régime théocratique dont les violences multiples exercées contre les corps marginalisés ont été rendues visibles par la mort de Mahsa.

Malgré la terreur et la répression, nous assistons aujourd'hui en Iran à une révolution féministe enflammée par la rage soulevée par l'assassinat de Mahsa (Zhina) Amini. Inspirés par le mouvement kurde, les manifestants scandent : « Femmes, vie, liberté ! »

Les soulèvements, les corps dansant sans hidjab et les manifestants brûlant les symboles du hidjab ont été violemment réprimés par des armées de « trolls » financées par l'Etat, des coupures d'Internet, des gaz lacrymogènes, des arrestations massives et des assassinats aveugles.

Une approche néo-orientaliste

Néanmoins, la communauté universitaire et militante à l'échelle internationale demeure largement silencieuse sur ce qui se passe aujourd'hui en Iran. La crise iranienne est enfermée dans deux cadres réducteurs et pourtant hégémoniques, dans les médias aussi bien que dans le milieu

académique.

D'un côté, la longue histoire d'oppression coloniale et la récente progression des discours xénophobes, racistes et sexistes en Occident ont amené à réduire des problèmes complexes, comme celui du hidjab, à des « questions culturelles ». Cela a notamment empêché les voix progressistes du Nord d'exprimer pleinement leur solidarité envers les luttes menées au Moyen-Orient et dans d'autres pays à majorité musulmane, de peur d'alimenter les idéologies sexistes en Occident.

D'un autre côté, une approche supposée progressiste mais, en réalité, néo-orientaliste a fait abstraction des vies et des subjectivités en dehors de l'Occident, en particulier de ceux qui vivent au Moyen-Orient ou en Afrique du Nord.

Ces cadres ont conduit à écarter épistémologiquement et politiquement les résistances féministes et queer [ou allosexuelles, altersexuelles, termes qui englobent les personnes ayant une sexualité ou une identité de genre différentes de l'hétérosexualité] en Iran. L'oppression multidimensionnelle subie et les combats menés restent ignorés, à moins qu'ils soient reliés à des problématiques occidentales ou que les acteurs se perçoivent eux-mêmes à travers ce regard néo-orientaliste.

Programme féministe et queer, anticapitaliste et antifasciste

Contre et au-delà de ces tendances réductrices, nous, un groupe d'universitaires militants féministes, demandons aux communautés féministes de nous rejoindre pour construire ensemble une solidarité transnationale avec les femmes et les corps marginalisés en Iran. Les combats de nos sœurs en Iran s'ancrent à la fois dans le développement historique des rapports de pouvoir au sein des sociétés dites « islamiques », et dans la crise contemporaine des relations de reproduction sociale dans le capitalisme mondial.

Nous insistons sur un programme féministe et queer, anticapitaliste et antifasciste qui ne réduise pas les luttes de nos alliées en Iran aux problèmes tels qu'on les rencontre dans les pays du Nord. Au contraire, nous devons considérer ces luttes dans un continuum et mener bataille en reconnaissant nos combats communs.

Créer et maintenir un tel continuum exige de reconnaître l'intersectionnalité des luttes que les femmes et autres corps marginalisés mènent dans des pays comme l'Iran et qui vivent actuellement dans une théocratie islamique. Il est aujourd'hui plus que jamais crucial de montrer une puissante solidarité transnationale envers les femmes et les autres corps marginalisés en Iran.
