Every day, news is dominated by the deepening economic crisis. We stand on the edge of a crisis of the system more profound than that of 2008. Faced with this, the ruling elites are paralysed. Their only plan is to push for even more austerity.

Trade-unionists and campaigners from across Europe and Britain will be at the Europe Against Austerity conference this Saturday to plan a united resistance of our public services, and to declare that we oppose all cuts and that we should not pay for this crisis.

OLME, the Greek federation of secondary education state school teachers, is just the latest organization to send representatives to the conference. The Greek government, along with the EU and IMF, are planning a 20% cut in pensions and the sacking of 100,000 public sector workers.

Resistance is continuing in Greece, Spain and Italy. In Britain, the planned strike of over 3million public sector workers on the 30th November will be our chance to start to push back the attacks. We are not "all in it together", and we should not pay for this crisis. Come to the conference this Saturday.
