

Kashmir Labour Party to contest elections in Kashmir

Kashmir Labour Party will contest the Kashmir general election to be held on 11th July 2006. Nisar Shah, chairperson KLP will contest for the Kashmir Assyby from constituency 4 of District Poonch.

On 2nd June, while submitting the election papers to the election commission, Nisar Shah declared that KLP will fight against the militarisation of relief and rehabilitation work in Kashmir. He said that we want an independent Socialist Kashmir and KLP will take the issue of national and class issues during the election campaign.

Nisar Shah, a local from this constituency was brought to Rawalakot in company of dozens of his supporters and a caravan with red flags travelled all the way from Paniola to Rawalkot to submit the nomination papers.

After the devastating earthquack of 8th October 2005, where over 100,000 lost their lives, Nisar Shah moved from Karachi to his native area of Paniola to help in relief work. He left his profession as advocate to do the relief and rehabilitation work. He was persuaded by his area people to contest the Kashmir assymbly elections.

Kashmir Labour Party is a sister organisation of Labour Party Pakistan and was formally announced recently. It has been registered in the election commission of Kashmir and in this election, Nisar Shah is the only candidate from KLP. There are 35 seats of the Kashmir Assembly.
