

Bangladesh (1996-2018): Commemoration of the 22nd Anniversary of the Death of Legendary Peasant Leader Comrade Abdus Satter Khan

A discussion meeting on 22nd death anniversary of the leading spirit in workers'-peasants' movement, one of the best organizers of liberation war and renowned and legendary peasant leader comrade Abdus Satter Khan was held.
